

GENERAL POOL RULES

No glass allowed within the pool enclosure.

No animals allowed within the pool enclosure

No, tobacco, candy, or food of any kind is permitted in the pool, or within 4 feet of the pool edge. Drinks are allowed at edge of pool only.

Persons with a sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, boils, or other acute or obvious skin or body infections, or cuts shall be excluded from the pool.

Smoking or Vaping will be allowed only in smoking areas which are outside of pool enclosure.

Persons who have been suffering from diarrhea should wait one day before coming back to pool.

All gates shall remain closed- do not prop open.

Shower before entering the pool.

If incontinent, tight fitting rubber or plastic pants, or a swim diaper must be worn while in the pool.

Children 10 years old and younger (red colored passes) can come with a teen at least 14 years old. Children 11 years old or older (orange colored passes) can come without an adult companion

All children under the age of 11 must be accompanied by a parent to be inside the baby pool gates.

Observe all safety regulations and rules.

Residents and guests must obey the direction of the pool lifeguards at all times. Failure to comply with the pool rules or lifeguard direction will result in removal from the pool and the potential loss of future pool privileges.

Vineyard's Pool Rules

Admission to the Pool Area

1. Admission to pool is limited to those residents who live in the Vineyards and are in good standing and their guests. This means grown children and grandchildren who do not live full time with their parents or grandparents will not be issued passes. They will be expected to use the guest pass provided, 2 per household, or buy day passes at \$3.00 each. If the resident shares custody or have custody of a child those children are entitled to a pass..
2. Admission to pool will be refused to anyone who has contagious diseases, open sores, or infectious conditions.
3. All swimmers must wear proper swim attire that must be hemmed. Cutoffs are not permitted.
4. Everyone must present a membership pass to enter the pool area.
5. Guests must present a guest pass and must be accompanied by a Vineyard resident at all times. Guest passes are for the use of non-Vineyards guests only.
6. Children 10 years old and younger can come with a teen 14 years old, or an older guardian. Children 11 years old or older can come without an adult companion. The Lifeguard has the right to administer a swim test at their discretion. The lifeguard also has the right to ask an unruly swimmer to leave the pool area. In such a case of unruly behavior, the membership pass will be held by the lifeguard until the parent of the unruly swimmer can discuss the situation, and no further admittance to the pool area will be allowed until the discussion with the parent/guardian takes place.

Conduct

1. No pets allowed.
2. No food is permitted within 4 foot of the pool. Drinks are allowed at the edge of the pool only. No glass containers are permitted inside the pool fence. All homeowner's and guests are responsible for cleaning up their trash.
3. There will be no smoking or vaping except in designated smoking areas which are outside the pool fence.
4. Barbecuing is not permitted inside the pool area.
5. No running, roughhouse play, chicken fights, tag, etc., are allowed.
6. Radios, "boom boxes", etc. should be audible to the individual resident only and not interfere with the conversations or enjoyment of other residents.
7. All swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
8. Babies are not permitted to wear diapers in the big pool or baby pool. They must wear watertight, plastic protective pants or swim diapers.
9. Babies are allowed in the big pool if accompanied by an adult, provided the babies are wearing watertight pants and only on non-holiday weekends.
10. Babies are allowed in the baby pool at all times provided they are supervised by an adult and are wearing watertight pants.
11. The lap lane is in the pool for swimming laps only. At the discretion of the lifeguards, a lap lane can be requested any time, Monday through Friday. On Saturday, Sunday and holidays, a lap lane can be requested during the first hour the pool is open.

12. There will be an "Adult Only" swim time consisting of the first or last 10 to 15 minutes of each hour (lifeguard discretion) the pool is open. An adult, in this case, is defined as anyone 18 years of age or older (green passes). All others must exit the pool during this time.
13. Diving is allowed at the deep end only and from the side. No running dives.
14. Do not carry on unnecessary conversations with, or distract the lifeguards.
15. The lifeguards have sole discretion in determining the appropriate use of any equipment or toy. Lawn chairs are not permitted in either the baby pool or the big pool.
16. All members shall drive slowly and carefully on the driveway and within the parking area of the pool.

Barbecue grills

17. The barbecue grills are available for use by the residents using the pool or clubhouse. They are available for use on first come first served basis.
18. Residents are expected to clean up after themselves around the grill.
19. The grills will be cleaned before using them. Ashes will be disposed of in the metal can provided.
20. Residents must bring their own charcoal, lighter fluid and cooking tools

Violations of the above rules and regulations may result in the following actions:

- 1st offense - 3 day suspension
- 2nd offense - 1 week suspension
- 3rd offense - 30 day suspension
- 4th offense - banned from the pool and clubhouse - parents and child must meet with the board for re-admission.

Passes will be kept in the office and must be picked up by a parent or guardian if a child is suspended from the pool and clubhouse.

If anyone is caught swimming:

- a. Outside of the stated pool hours,
- b. When the pool is closed for a holiday or weather,
- c. When a lifeguard is not present, or
- d. In the event of a fourth formal incident report within a 12-month period, it is an automatic suspension from the pool and clubhouse and the offending child and parent or the offending adult must appear before the board before readmission.

If anyone is banned or suspended, they cannot use the pool or clubhouse.

Damage to clubhouse property, including trees and shrubbery, will not be permitted and any member that shall cause such damage shall be held financially responsible.

The lifeguard has the discretion to pull the pass of anyone in the pool area for safety or behavior issues. Everyone using the pool is expected to respect the authority of the lifeguards.

Violators will be banned from the pool!

Offenses will include formal incident reports and are considered in 12-month periods. Suspension is from the Pool and the Clubhouse.
